### The Trestleboard in color

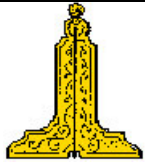

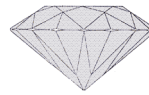

## Masonic Facts and Definitions

Tiler: Also spelled “tyler”. In the Latin tegere (from which came “thatch”) meant cover, roof; tegulae were the tiles, pieces, or slabs used for roof coverings. A tiler, therefore, is one who makes, or fastens on, tiles. Since in Operative Masonry the Tiler was the workman who closed the building in, and hid its interior from outside view, the guardian of the entrance to the Lodge was figuratively called by his name. It was once supposed that “tiler” came from the French tailleur, a cutter, a hewer (from whence we have “tailor”), and was accordingly spelled “tyler” that, however, is incorrect, “tiler” being the correct spelling.
